For your child to be eligible to enrol for Out of School Tuition, applicants must be:

- Aged between 8 and 18 years (or 5-18 years if at Kura Kaupapa);
- Attending school; and
- Registered with Whakapapa Ngāi Tahu.

Applications must be made by a member of the student's immediate whānau. While anyone who meets the above criteria can apply for this one-off funding, first time applicants (including senior students sitting examinations) are prioritised. Each child/youth is limited to one lot of 10 sessions in any financial year (July 1st – June 30th).

BACKGROUND

Out of School Tuition is a one-off programme which offers 10 tuition sessions (over 1 school term) to Ngāi Tahu children. It provides additional support, both remedial (catch-up) and extension (for gifted children), and for senior secondary students sitting examinations in Term 4.

Each term, Te Rūnanga supports students through the provision of Out of School Tuition across New Zealand. The intention of this pūtea is to complement the support which should already be provided by your child's school.

If you are unsure of the support provided by the school, you might like to talk to your child's classroom teacher or the school principal.
